

If you previously attended UNLV as an undergraduate and would like to return to finish your program, you must do the following:

1. Submit a bank letter certifying the availability of funds sufficient to cover the estimated expenses for the 2008-2009 academic year (USD\$33,450.00 for undergraduate students). Funds may come from any dependable source, including scholarships, fellowships, sponsoring agencies, personal funds, or funds from the student's family. Documentation of scholarships and fellowships may be in the form of an official award letter from the school or sponsoring agency; documentation of personal or family funds should be on bank letterhead stationery. **The bank letter must be signed or stamped by a bank official and dated no more than one year prior to your first day of class.** Please include the student's name on the bank letter, so that we can match it with the student's file.
2. Submit a fully completed Confidential Financial Certificate Form (available at [www.unlv.edu/studentlife/international/forms/Financial\\_Certification.pdf](http://www.unlv.edu/studentlife/international/forms/Financial_Certification.pdf)). **The confidential financial certification must be dated no more than one year prior to your first day of class.** A separate affidavit of support will not be accepted in place of the financial certificate form. Please complete all applicable sections of this form. We will not issue the I-20 if any of the required information is missing.
3. Submit a completed Undergraduate Returning Student form to ISS (available at [registrar.unlv.edu/PDF/UndergradReturn.pdf](http://registrar.unlv.edu/PDF/UndergradReturn.pdf)).
4. Check in with ISS and provide us with current copies of your passport, visa and I-94. Please call 895-0143 to schedule your **Returning Student check in** appointment.

You must also submit any new official transcripts to Student Enrollment Services. If you have questions about transferring credits, please contact the department of your major.
